## ABOUTTERRADISE NATURE CENTER

1536 Whetstone River Road North Caledonia, Ohio 43314

- 5+-Acre nature preserve along the Whetstone (Olentangy) River outside of Caledonia (Marion County)
- Historic home of Trella & Ray Romine: pioneering Caledonia conservationists, local historians, artists, & naturalists ---Romine Residence built in 1953
- Converted to a 501(c)(3) non-profit in 2018, following Trella Romine's passing in 2013, to open the property for enjoyment to all
- Mission: "to inform our communities about their cultural <u>and</u> natural heritages"
- Open dawn-to-dusk, 365/day year; # of environmental, arts, & heritage programs



# ABOUTTERRADISE NATURE CENTER

History of "Terradise"

- Historically-important stretch of the Whetstone (Olentangy) River: long history of use by indigenous communities; & as a popular fishing hole for the Caledonia community
- Purchased by Trella & Ray Romine in 1952, following Trella Romine's dream of a house "on a hill, by a river, in a woods"
- The name "Terradise" is a neologism by Marion's "Postman Poet" Ray Romine, meaning heaven on Earth
- Terradise kickstarted many important local history, heritage, & conservation movements in Marion County: especially the Sandusky Plains prairie conservation movement, which Trella spearheaded from the 1970s through 2010s

**PROGRAMMING** 

- Environmental Education: School-based educational programs; "Feet on the Ground, Hands-On" Conservation Series; prairie restorations
- Retreat Visits: Rental of the Romine Residence as overnight AirBnB for nature getaways; rentable for board meetings
- Romine Legacy Committee: Heritage programming interpreting the history, lives, & amplifying the work of Trella & Ray Romine: including digitization projects. Caledonia Conservationists exhibit forthcoming in 2023!
- Arts & Culture Programming: including our Terradise Environmental Arts Residency & Tunes at Terradise Series

**FUTURE:** Interpretive Center!



- Paid artist's residency for artists <u>living in</u>, <u>working in</u>, or <u>from</u> Marion or Morrow Counties
- Non-Residential: visit Terradise 3x during your residency month
- Residency Project: pitch a project -- create new work, during your residency month, inspired by our property, history, mission, or legacy!
- Public Program: collaborate with your fellow monthly artist on a 2-hour public program (we'll help & promote!) ... could be a talk, workshop, performance, reading, activity ... you name it!
- Stipend of \$1,000 to support our artists
- **<u>Eight</u>** slots available in 2023: March-June



- Open to artists in <u>all genres</u>: including the folk/traditional arts, fine arts, performance arts, music, writing, outdoorsmanship ... lots of options!
- Especially seeking artists from marginalized backgrounds/communities, who have not had the chance to have a paid or supported opportunity to produce original creative work
- TEAR is the <u>only</u> artist's residency in Marion & Morrow County; & the only paid artist's residency in the North-Central Ohio region!
- TEAR is generously supported by an ArtsNEXT Grant from the Ohio Arts Council ... thank you for making this possible!
