DETAILS:

- **\$1,000 stipend** for a month-long, self-directed, *non-residential* artist residency
- Awarded to **two Marion or Morrow county artists** per month, **March - June 2023** (8 total residency slots available); final awards will depend on number of applicants.
- Open to artists in **all genres** -- fine arts, folk & cultural arts, creative writing, theatre, music, dance, foodways, herbalism, woodworking, spoken word ... surprise us!
- **Artists of color, immigrant artists, queer & trans* artists, disabled artists, youth & elders**, & those from **historically-marginalized backgrounds** are encouraged to apply!
- **Requirements:**
 - **Explore Terradise!** Make at least 3 visits to Terradise Nature Center in Caledonia.
 - **Create New Art!** Make work inspired by Terradise Nature Center, our property, the history & work of founders Trella & Ray Romine (pioneering Marion County conservationists, local historians, & artists), or the Whetstone (Olentangy) River!
 - **Artist Event:** Co-host a two-hour public program, workshop, or artists' talk at the end of your residency month -- either via Zoom or outside at Terradise. We'll promote it!
